The AHRC has announced a call for UK researchers to attend a workshop in Istanbul on '[Development through the Creative Industries in Turkey](#)'. Organised in partnership with the Istanbul Development Agency, the event will bring together experts from both countries to explore how the Creative Industries play a critical role for growth and prosperity in the Istanbul region.

A key aim of the workshop is to enable researchers and key stakeholders from the UK and Turkey to develop new partnerships with a view to longer-term collaboration. Discussions at the workshop will inform an AHRC call for Research Networking projects, which will launch shortly afterwards.
