

# 2024 Early Career / Junior Scholar Workshop

The Asian Law and Society Association (ALSA) is pleased to announce the call for applications for the Early Career / Junior Scholar Workshop on 12 December 2024. The one-day workshop will convene immediately preceding the 2024 ALSA Annual Meeting (13-14 December) at Sungkyunkwan University, Seoul, Korea.

# Eligibility

We welcome applications from doctoral students in the late stages of their education, research or postdoctoral fellows who completed their doctoral degrees no earlier than 1 May 2021, and faculty members in the first three years of their academic careers (we do not accept applications from LL.M. or undergraduate students). If an applicant has a career break due to the pandemic or family obligations, the committee will review eligibility on a case-by-case basis.

# The Workshop

Participants will be encouraged to develop their research and writing toward law-and-society topics relevant to Asian societies, advance their knowledge and understanding of the field, and build a diverse intellectual community. The workshop offers insights into key debates and analytical trends in the field; research methodologies; writing and publishing. Participants will receive feedback on one's research project and papers. The program will consist of seminars led by senior and emerging law and society scholars.

Application for the workshop will be competitive. Applicants trained in law, the social sciences, and humanities are welcome. Participants will be asked to submit a paper or a chapter of their written work for presentation and discussion during the workshop. This paper may be presented at the ALSA conference as well.

### Cost

There is no registration fee for the workshop. Selected participants are expected to pay for their own travel and accommodation. Meals and refreshments during the workshop and ground transportation between the workshop venue and hotel will be provided.

### Deadline

Applications are due June 24, 2024. Successful applicants will be notified by July 31, 2024.
