

The CLS Visiting Fellowship Call 2024/25

The Centre of Law and Society invites early career scholars and emerging researchers to apply for the CLS fellowships in the academic year 2024/25. Associated with the internationally prestigious Journal of Law and Society, the Centre offers a stimulating academic environment for socio-legal scholars to conduct research of the highest quality. The programme will be run in both a virtual and in-person capacity, with the possibility of a grant of up to £1,000 for in-person visitors.

Applications are welcome from UK and overseas scholars in the fields of sociology of law and socio-legal studies. Successful in-person applicants will be granted access to the University's Libraries during their stay.

All fellowships will be awarded for the period of up to one semester during the academic year 2024/25.

Applicants are expected to make initial contact with their preferred academic sponsor from the *School of Law and Politics* who will be acting as their point of contact through their visit. As part of their application, they will submit a brief description (max. 1000 words) of their research project and an academic CV.

Successful candidates are expected to participate in the Centre's online Work in Progress sessions and contribute at least one research seminar during their stay as well as submit a short report at the end of their visit.

Please note, PhD students on in-person visits, must begin their visit either in October or January only.
